

The PTWA Referral For Profit (RFP) Chair shall be responsible for leadership of the RFP Committee and performing or assigning the following:

- Communicating/reporting to the PTWA Board of Directors through the Practice Panel Director or directly to the board as requested.
- Communicating/coordinating with APTA's RFP Committee and regional liaison as appropriate.
- Communicating/coordinating with the PTWA Legislative Committee regarding any Washington Legislative or congressional issues related to RFP issues.
- Serve as a the clearinghouse for PTWA staff when questions arise regarding a possible RFP clinic wishing to utilize ptwa marketing programs-
- Submit articles about RFP issues and news to the PTWA newsletter on an occasional basis.
- Ensure a presence regarding RFP at PTWA Fall and Spring conferences via a booth and literature.
- As requested by the PTWA Board of Directors or President, present at Chapter Meetings or other appropriate venues, such as the PPSIG annual meeting, regarding RFP.
- Establish and maintain contact with the Northwest PT/PTA schools to serve as a resource, such as for speakers, materials or concerns related to RFP.
- Attempt to maintain an accurate list of current RFP clinics in Washington state.
- Be a contact point for PTWA members' questions and concerns regarding RFP issues.
